- Completed and signed 'Questions to be answered prior to your Co-op Interview'

WHAT WILL WE CONSIDER?

Screening:

- Attendance
- Marks
- Commitment / Suitability (Teacher References)

Interview:

- If you submit your completed application package, you will receive an interview appointment slip for the <u>week of March 26</u>
- If you did not submit your 'Questions to be answered prior to your Co-op interview' WITH the rest of your application package, then bring it with you TO YOUR INTERVIEW

Just follow the steps listed on the cover page of your application package and submit all the completed documents to the application drop box outside of the Co-op Office (2114) by

TUESDAY, MARCH 20...

...then wait to be scheduled for an interview

REMEMBER AND STICK TO THE KEY DATES...

TUESDAY, MARCH 20...

 Application, resume, 2 teacher reference forms, 'Questions to be answered prior to your Co-op interview' submitted to Mr. Kemperman in basket outside the Co-op Office (2114)

WEEK OF MARCH 26TH...

- Interviews begin. You'll receive an appointment slip in your homeroom giving you the date, time & location (2114)
- If you don't submit it with the rest of your application package, come to the interview with your 'Questions to be answered prior to your Co-op interview' completed and signed
